

Sierra Vista Soccer Club Registration Fall 2019-2020

1. All registration is online. If you need assistance, there will be sessions listed on the web site where board members can help you through the online registration process.
2. You must have the username and password for your player account or family account before you proceed. Every player who played soccer in Arizona already has a Got Soccer player account.

Parents can import player accounts into family accounts so multiple children can be registered at once. The family discount is only available if you use a family account for registration.

When creating a new account, please use proper capitalization. Rosters, Game Cards, and Player Passes are automatically generated using player data. They either truncate information or are difficult to read if correct capitalization is not used.

If you don't know your credentials, follow one of these processes.

- a. Go to https://www.gotsport.com/asp/users/login_menu.asp?tab=member and follow the hyperlink for either "Player Account Lookup" or "Family Account Lookup".
- b. If you don't have access to the email address used previously, contact the SVSC registrar at registrar@svsoccer.net to update your email address or have your password reset.

If you create a duplicate account, it will not include your player history. You will be treated as a new player and requests will not be honored.

3. When registration is complete, you will receive a confirmation email from "Club Manager <support@gotsport.com>". Please configure your email spam filter to allow email from this address.

You can see team assignment by viewing the Got Soccer player profile. Note that during the team formation process, a player may be moved to a different team. When team formation is complete, roster information is provided to your coach. The coach will then contact you to start practice.

4. Registration using a family account.
 - a. Click on the program player registration link <https://www.gotsport.com/asp/application/reg/?ProgramID=72789&Type=PLAYER>
 - b. Click on the button "Login to Family Account"
 - c. The club registration program should be listed if it is not see steps (5 & 6) below
 - d. Each player must be registered individually. This will go more smoothly if the player profiles are complete and current.
 - e. Next to each player click on the "Register Now" button. Information from the player profile will automatically fill the application so you don't have to type it again.
 - f. Read and check the box agreeing to the AYSA Code of Conduct.
 - g. Read and check the box agreeing to the AYSA Head Injury/Concussion policy.

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- h. Enter any requests. The reason for the request may assist the team formation committee's decision when not all requests can be met.
 - i. The emergency information page will be populated from the player profile. If there are changes enter them here. This page is used to generate the medical release form the coach will have at practice and games should an injury occur when you are not present.
 - j. Enter your full name then check the box agreeing to the AYSA registration policy.
 - k. Click the button that says "Finish and Submit Application". Please note the player is not registered until this box is clicked.
 - l. Print the medical release form for your coach if you wish. This is done by clicking on the "Printable Registration Form" button. It is populated with the information from the "Emergency Info" tab of the player profile.
 - m. "Click Here" to return to the family account to register additional players
5. If your player account is not associated with the "Sierra Vista SC"
- a. Click on the "Clubs" tab
 - b. In the pull-down select "Arizona"
 - c. In the Club Name box type "Sierra"
 - d. Click on the "Go" button
 - e. Click on "Select" for the Sierra Vista SC
6. If the program does not already show.
- a. Under the player name and club, there is a hyperlink "View Available Programs"
 - b. Click on it
 - c. If the program does not show here, you may search for it.
 - d. In the pull-down select "Arizona"
 - e. In the Club Name box type "Sierra"
 - f. Click on the "Go" button
 - g. Click "Select" next to "SVSC registration fall 19-20"

7. Registration using an individual account
- a. The online player program registration link for the fall 2019-2020 season is <https://www.gotsport.com/asp/application/reg/?ProgramID=72789&Type=PLAYER>
Click on the link
 - b. In the "Registered Users" box enter the username and password for the player account.
Click on the "Login" button
If you have forgotten the Username or password, click on the "Player Password lookup" hyperlink.
 - c. Check the box that says "I am over the age of 13 or am the legal guardian of the above player."
 - d. Click on the "Continue" button.
 - e. Read and check the box agreeing to the AYSA Code of Conduct.
 - f. Read and check the box agreeing to the AYSA Head Injury/Concussion policy.

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- g. Enter any requests. The reason for the request may assist the team formation committee's decision when not all requests can be met.
 - h. The emergency information page will be populated from the player profile. If there are changes enter them here. This page is used to generate the medical release form the coach will have at practice and games should an injury occur when you are not present.
 - i. Click "Continue" on the next page.
 - j. Select a payment method and complete the necessary information.
 - k. Enter your full name then check the box agreeing to the AYSA registration policy.
 - l. Click the button that says "Finish and Submit Application". Please note the player is not registered until this box is clicked.
8. New players, who have not played soccer previously in Arizona, go to the same link and create a new account. The player's birth date will need to be verified by uploading a copy of the birth certificate to the player account or mailing it to the registrar at:

Uploaded documents may be deleted by the parent once the age is verified by the registrar. This can be done any time after games start.

Mailed documents are shredded after verification so do not mail original documents. The birth certificate must be a Government issued document. Hospital or baptismal certificates are not accepted.

9. Player age brackets in the United States were changed for the 2016-2017 season. Players in age brackets below 5-U are not accepted by SVSC. The calendar year age bracket chart for this season is posted at <http://svsoccer.net> .
